From specialist to attractive allrounder

The Putzmeister Telebelt (Telescopic Belt Conveyor) is a versatile construction machine for placing concrete and a range of other materials up to a diameter of 300 mm. The constant pulsation and pressure-free material transport on the belt allows for high placement (up to 450 m³/h) with low operating costs.

The world's biggest population of Telebelt machines is in the USA. There, the Telebelt is used by service providers as an addition to the truck-mounted concrete pump and places not only concrete, but also hardcore, gravel, sand and other materials on construction sites.

Outside the USA, the Telebelt has previously been used predominantly in dam construction. The reason for this is its strength in delivering standard concretes and non-pumpable concretes, such as coarse concrete, earth-moist concrete or roller compacted concrete. The Telebelt is also excellently suited to special placement tasks in gardening and landscaping. There, materials like sand, earth and mulch can be conveyed.

With the new semi-trailer version TBS 130, it was possible to change the fields of use world-wide quickly from specialist to allrounder. The semi-trailer now enables operation of a wide range of tractor units as a Telebelt with just minimal adaptation effort. The country-specific approval for road use must be checked, however, a special chassis is no longer required in Europe.

Separate information box:

What does this mean for the operator or investor?

- significantly lower investment
- almost every make can be used as the tractor unit, even a used machine or a machine from an existing fleet
- onward sale is subject to hardly any restrictions in terms of approval for road use and the exhaust gas standard of the chassis. This makes financing easier.
- lower fuel consumption through the use of the independent power unit belonging to the semi-trailer
- significantly lower wear costs per m³ than with truck-mounted concrete pumps

The Telebelt is therefore worth it not only for the high placement volumes of large projects. This is reason enough to see a familiar subject in a new light.
